



The Pembroke Regional Hospital is currently looking an Orthopaedic Surgeon for Long Term Locum with the Potential for Full Time

The Pembroke Regional Hospital (PRH) is a secondary referral hospital situated in Pembroke, Ontario on the shores of the Ottawa River and in close proximity to Algonquin Park. The hospital provides the following clinical programs and services: emergency medicine, internal medicine, family medicine (including a hospitalist program), ICU, mental health, acute rehabilitation, anesthesiology, obstetrics/gynecology and surgical services including general surgery, otolaryngology, urology and ophthalmology. A full array of diagnostic and laboratory services are provided. Medical imaging services include: MRI, CT, nuclear medicine, ultrasound, fluoroscopy and X-ray.

We support a number of smaller hospitals in the Ottawa Valley providing service to a total population of approximately 100,000. The Emergency Department has 36,000 visits a year divided between acute care and fast track areas. The ED is staffed by a multi-disciplinary team of nurses, physicians, and respiratory therapists. The clinical programs at PRH are supported by social services, pastoral care and a crisis intervention team, in addition to speech, occupational and physio therapy. We have well established referral protocols with the tertiary care centres in Ottawa (140 km from PRH).

The Orthopaedic Surgery Program at the Pembroke Regional Hospital provides comprehensive elective and emergency surgical care as well as non-surgical orthopaedic management. Multi-system trauma, spinal and oncological orthopaedic services will not be provided.

Locums will be offered a turn key office with a trained receptionist with associated costs. Office days to be determined depending on OR and fracture clinic days. One day in the Operating Room per week

½ day Fracture Clinic

On Call days as worked between the group

Accommodations can also be offered at low cost if required.

Surgeons will provide emergency consultations and perform trauma procedures (e.g. fracture repairs).

Requirements:

- Fully independent registration (or eligibility) with College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO);
- Certified by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada – FRCP(C) in Orthopedics
- Willing to relocate to be within the on-call area.

Although located at the Pembroke Regional Hospital, the Program will be affiliated with the Champlain Regional Orthopaedic Network which includes major centres of activity at The Ottawa Hospital, the Queensway-Carleton Hospital, the Montfort Hospital and the Cornwall Community Hospital.

There is a potential for a full time position for successful locums. Physician will be expected to be a full-time active members of our surgical program including providing on-call coverage.
