

FULL TIME AND LOCUM PSYCHIATRISTS

Pembroke Regional Hospital, Pembroke, Ontario

Located one and a half hours west of Ottawa, the Pembroke Regional Hospital (PRH) delivers a broad range of acute, post-acute, outpatient and diagnostic services to a mixed urban and rural population of approximately 100,000 residents in the Upper Ottawa Valley. **PRH is recruiting two psychiatrists to provide General Psychiatry clinical care for outpatients and inpatients. There are also locum opportunities available.**

The hospital is situated on the shores of the Ottawa River close to Algonquin Park and provides an array of diagnostic and specialist services including CT, MRI, Hospitalist program, Internal Medicine, Surgery and an Inpatient Rehabilitation program. A full Orthopedic program is currently in the planning stages.



The Mental Health program at PRH is comprised of comprehensive outpatient services including a psychiatric clinic, Assertive Community Treatment Team (ACTT), Community Mental Health case management, crisis team and social work counselling services. We also have a 15 bed non schedule 1 Acute Mental Health Unit. We are affiliated with the University of Ottawa and local family medicine residents complete their core psychiatry training here.

There are currently two full-time members in the Department of Psychiatry and we are interested in expanding our services by recruiting two more full-time Psychiatrists who would be involved in inpatient and outpatient care. We are flexible and innovative and welcome input from potential colleagues on the structure of the program and service delivery models.

While recruiting, we also need locums to provide service on weekends and several weeks throughout the year on a flexible time schedule.

Position Requirements

- Fully independent registration (or eligible for) with College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO)
- Certified by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada – FRCP(C) in Psychiatry
- Experience working with teams and possessing strong interpersonal and collaborative skills
- We are seeking General Adult Psychiatrists, but an interest in outpatient, psychotherapy, Geriatric Psychiatry, outpatient Child Psychiatry or Electroconvulsive Therapy would be given preference.

There is the potential to have a robust, full-time, rewarding career working in a collegial environment. Remuneration would be based on a fee-for-service model plus sessional allocation. On call coverage is reasonable and flexible and supported by on call funds through the Hospital On Call Coverage program (HOCC). We invite you to join our team of skilled and dedicated healthcare professionals.
