

Paid Parking Improvements Coming Soon To Pembroke Regional Hospital

PEMBROKE - A new, more modern parking system will soon be installed in the Deacon Street and Tower D parking lots at the Pembroke Regional Hospital.

The parking system upgrade scheduled to take place May 31st to June 2nd will include a number of new features such as contactless debit and credit card payment with tap, WAVE technology for contactless ticket entry and upgraded intercoms which will improve communication and remote assistance.

Tracey Chiviendacz, Facility Manager for SP+ which operates paid parking at PRH said both parking lots will remain open during the installation.

While parking rates won't be impacted by the upgrade, Ms. Chiviendacz said those individuals who have purchased Frequent User Cards for the current system will need to visit the parking office starting June 3rd to receive a new one as existing cards aren't compatible with the new machines.

The SP+ office, room C004, located in the corridor adjacent to Mulvihill Drug Mart in Tower C is open Monday to Friday 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

The parking revenue at Pembroke Regional Hospital is invested in areas of improvement that are not provincially funded.
