

Today's Take-Aways

As the situation regarding COVID-19 continues to change, please note that the most recent information, guidance and updates can be found in the weekly Pulse newsletter which is archived in the Staff Resources section of the hospital's website. Important COVID-related memos are also archived in this location and can also be found on the Intranet.

Regional Updates

- Ottawa hospitals are finding themselves in improved circumstances with occupancies in most slightly under 100% and the health care teams feeling cautiously optimistic that the situation is improving.
- The number of Alternate Level of Care (ALC) patients is also on the decline thanks to a number of supports put in place including the opening of a new ALC transitional care facility in Ottawa.
- Regional planning for COVID-19 vaccine distribution is underway with toolkits in development, various meetings taking place and discussions around logistics starting to happen.
- Public Health is expected to issue some messaging around Christmas in the coming days urging caution in holiday plans and asking everyone to maintain diligence around COVID safety measures even though we have low transmission rates in Renfrew County.

Supplies

• There are emerging concerns about the availability of Nitrile gloves and gloves in general. Specifically, it is anticipated that there may be a significant shortage in the first quarter of 2021. In addition we are noticing an increase in use at PRH. To get ahead of any possible shortages there may be some control measures put in place around glove usage as well as an evaluation of anticipated demand.

Occupational Health and Safety

• At this time approximately 51% of our health care team have received the flu shot. If you would like to get a flu shot, call 7202 to book appointment. Plans are also being made to host a flu shot clinic for family members of staff. Stay tuned for more details!

Infection Prevention and Control

• Now that the COVID-friendly guidelines for the holiday season have been issued, departments will now be receiving their Christmas decorations on the units.

Clinical Updates

• Acute Mental Health – Staff have taken the initiative and are developing education to share with other departments in the hospital regarding the care of mental health patients in other areas including critical care and rehabilitation. More details to come on this.




GRATITUDE


