News Related To COVID-19

Regional Updates

- Overall, the number of active COVID cases requiring hospitalization in Ottawa is slowly decreasing as is the overall infection rate. In Renfrew County, Public Health is reporting that we are in fairly good shape but noting that everyone needs to remain vigilant in their practices to ensure that we stay this way.
- The number of Alternate Level of Care patients throughout the region remains high but there is expected to be some relief with the opening of Bruyère's new facility which we also anticipate will be able to accommodate some of our ALC patients.

Human Resources

• Staff should anticipate some communication coming out with regards to managing staff gatherings over the holiday season while maintaining COVID safety measures.

Supplies

- Everything is fairly stable at this point. We are in the process of assessing demand for Medium sized Nitrile gloves as there remain challenges with this item. We are also working towards acquiring additional stock of disposable isolation gowns as demand for these has increased.
- In the recent announcements around the provincial budget, the creation of a new Crown Corporation to manage PPE distribution was highlighted. More to come on this but they have indicated that the intent will be to use Canadian-made items and partner with Canadian manufactures to insure supply for the future.

Occupational Health and Safety

• The roll out of the flu vaccine to our health care team continues. As of November 17th, 375 staff, 47 physicians and 39 student/volunteers have received their flu shot. If you would like to get a flu shot, call 7202 to book appointment. Departments can also arrange to have flu shots available at huddles if that is more convenient. If you have received a flu shot in the community, please advise Occupational Health by email (occhealth@prh.email) and if possible, attach a copy of your proof of vaccination.

Clinical Updates

- Diagnostic Imaging is in the process of scheduling MRI and CT bookings for those on Ottawa wait lists to assist patients who are in need.
- The Surgical department is also making accommodations for Ottawa area patients. Once a week, our orthopaedic surgeons, assisted by anaesthetists from Ottawa are taking on cases from Ottawa hospital waitlists.


