

## Today's Take-Aways

**PLEASE NOTE** - Due to a scheduling change in the frequency of PRH management meetings where COVID and non-COVID related news items are shared, The Pulse is going to transition to a bi-weekly publication after today.

As a result, the next edition will be published on Thursday, August 19th. Should the volume of news ramp up, the publication frequency of The Pulse newsletter will once again be amended.

#### **Regional Updates**

• Regionally and throughout the province, a lack of amended guidance on a number of pandemic related policies and procedures for the health care sectors is causing some issues and resulting in a number of hospitals and health care facilities developing their own policies and procedures to address items such as policies around vaccinated versus unvaccinated staff.

It is anticipated that local discussions could take place on some of these matters in the coming weeks to determine, in conjunction with public health, if some updates to guidance in our region could be developed and at least aligned within Renfrew County hospitals.

#### **COVID-19 Vaccine Distribution**

• As mass clinics ramp down, and the vaccination distribution transitions to both primary care settings and pharmacies, it is anticipated that some local messaging may centre around the remaining unvaccinated population which is anticipated to be comprised of approximately 17,000 people – many of whom are in the 12-40 year age category.

#### **Critical Care**

• Despite the recent transition which has enabled COVID-positive patients to be cared for on the most appropriate clinical unit, PRH continues to be the designated hospital for those COVID positive individuals requiring hospitalization.

#### **Departmental Updates:**

• Increasing patient volumes are being seen throughout the organization. This is coupled with broadbased staffing challenges during the peak vacation period.

• Organization wide we are anticipating a ramp up of student places starting September 17th.

#### **Emergency Department / ICU**

• The ED continues to see high volumes of patients however the use of Zone B is helping to decrease the length of stay for those assessed as having lower acuity reasons for their visit.

Staff and families are appreciating the increased number of visitors allowed for those patients who
are receiving end-of-life care.

## **Today's Take-Aways Continued**

#### **Diagnostic Imaging**

 Wait times for MRI are on the rise despite the additional funded hours provided by the Ministry of Health.

 The department is also exploring ways to improve the availability of Ultrasound appointments for ED patients and reduce wait times for that modality.

#### Food Services

• Some discussions around the re-opening of the cafeteria to the public took place however, since there are currently no measures in place allowing visitors to consume food on the premises or in patient rooms, this decision has been deferred until further guidance has been provided.
