### Today's Take-Aways COVID-19 – Regional Updates

# • A press release was issued on behalf of Renfrew County's five hospitals Wednesday, sharing news that all facilities will transition from active to passive screening in the coming weeks.

At PRH, we are anticipating a shift to passive screening starting early next week. As we anticipate some challenges in the early days of transition, we will be looking to each of you to be patient and assist where possible in ensuring those in our hospital adhere to the continued safety measures and guidelines. If you have questions or require assistance in particular circumstances, please connect with your manager.

### **Infection Prevention and Control**

• Earlier this week, a memo was sent out regarding changes to PPE requirements which took effect June 28th. These included:

- Elimination of universal masking in non-clinical areas where staff and physicians are seated and can safely maintain 6 feet of physical distancing at all times.

- Staff and physicians MUST continue to wear a mask in non-clinical areas where staff are moving around (ie. walking in hallways, using elevators, etc) and for any interaction with other staff, patients, visitors and members of the public. Universal masking remains in effect for clinical areas. If you see anyone without a mask, kindly remind them that they are still required.

- Elimination of universal eye protection in clinical areas. Eye protection must be worn based on the point of care risk assessment (PCRA) and according to routine practices and additional precautions, including when providing care to suspect and confirmed COVID-19 patients. Units on outbreak for COVID-19 must continue to adhere to universal eye protection for the duration of the outbreak.

- Staff and physicians no longer need to complete electronic screening prior to each shift, but are reminded of their COVID-19 attestation completed via eLearning in which they agree to self-identify new signs and symptoms and follow all health and safety practices.

• Painting and the suspended ceiling grid installation were started in the new Physician Lounge.


• The renovation of the Geriatric Day Hospital on the Ground floor of Tower C is almost complete. We are just waiting for some fire alarm detectors.
