SUBJECT: Planned Medical Air Shutdown

There will be a planned medical gas shutdown on **Tuesday, August 15th starting at 9:00 am** for a duration of approximately **two (2) days**. This is required for the Surgical Day Care project in order to start up a new medical air unit (skid) which will be replacing the existing one.

Oxygen, and Medical Vacuum will **not** be affected throughout the Hospital during this time.

Nitrous Oxide will not be available on LDRP during this timeframe.

The two-day duration is to allow for air sampling and analysis which is done remotely before the system can be switched over.

Contingency plans have been developed and will be in place for the duration of the shutdown. If any issues come up during the shutdown, please contact on-call maintenance at (613) 639-1486.
