**SUBJECT:** Planned Medical Gas Shutdown

---

There will be a planned medical gas shutdown on **Tuesday, December 6<sup>th</sup> starting at 4:00 pm** for a duration of 2-4 hours. This is required in order to install more isolation or shut off valves for the Surgical Day Care construction project.

Oxygen, Medical Air, Medical Vacuum and Nitrous Oxide will all be affected throughout the Hospital during this time.

There will be a second planned medical gas shutdown on **Thursday, December 8<sup>th</sup> starting at 4:00 pm** for a duration of 1-2 hours. This is required in order to connect new oxygen and medical air lines for Tower D. This shutdown will only affect the OR.

Contingency plans have been developed and will be in place for the duration of the shutdown. Just prior to the shutdown, there will be an overhead announcement and Command Centre will be operational at ext. 6199.
