With state-of-the-art services and associated technologies in place, PRH has earned a strong reputation as a teaching hospital; currently holding affiliation agreements with the University of Ottawa's faculties of Medicine and a local Family Medicine Residency program where the residents complete most of their core rotation here at PRH.
